



What Can I RECYCLE

A guide to recycling provided by Recycle Midwest.

PLASTIC

YES

General plastic containers with the codes 1 through 7 printed on the bottom are acceptable.

Preparation

Rinse Containers, Remove and discard caps.

Containers must be clean.

NO

- Unrinsed bottles
- Lids, rings or caps
- Brittle plastic that will break or crack
- Bread wrappers
- Plastic bags
- Plastic wrapping paper
- Oil and anti-freeze containers
- Toys
- Styrofoam
- Plastic lids

ALUMINUM

YES

- Any household aluminum including cans, foil, etc.

Preparation

Rinse cans.

Cans must be clean.

NO

- Unrinsed cans

CARDBOARD

YES

- Packing Boxes
- Paperboard such as cereal, cake mix, and cracker boxes.
- Pulp fiber such as egg cartons and drink holders

Preparation

Remove all other material such as styrofoam

NO

Waxy Cardboard such as meat boxes.

GLASS

YES

- Clear glass
- Green glass
- Brown glass
- Bottles and jars

Preparation

Rinse bottles and remove lids.

Containers must be clean.

NO

- Unrinsed bottles
- Broken glass
- Lids, rings or caps
- Ceramic
- Porcelain
- Window glass
- Dishes
- Vases
- "Contamination" means non recyclable

PAPER

YES

- Newsprint
- White Paper
- Computer Paper
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Manila Envelopes
- Office Waste
- File Folders
- Phone Books
- Shredded Paper
- Envelopes with plastic window coverings

Preparation

Remove all other material such as styrofoam

NO

Waxy Cardboard such as meat boxes.

TIN

YES

- Any household food or beverage container, including pet foods cans.

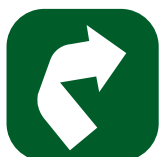
Preparation

Rinse cans. No need to remove labels or lids.

Cans must be clean.

NO

- Unrinsed cans
- Aerosol cans
- Cans used for storage of gasoline, kerosene and paint
